- **Campeche** A fortified city on the Yucatán's western edge, this UNESCO World Heritage Site's cobblestone streets are lined with restored facades. Guests enjoy cultural points of interest including Puerta de Tierra, El Palacio de Centro Cultural and Our Lady of Immaculate Conception Cathedral.
- Valladolid (Chichén Itzá) After a delectable dinner and relaxing overnight stay at the colorful Mayaland Hotel family-owned and operated since 1923 guests will awake within walking distance to the mystical ruins of Chichén Itzá and greet the sun as it rises over the fascinating El Castillo the Temple of Kukulkan.
- Mayan World of Edzna One of the most interesting Mayan cities due to the technological advances discovered along with architecture influenced by the Puuc, Peten and Chenes style, Edzna features numerous religious and residential buildings for discovery.
